

Lee Stars in Special Edition of Family Feud

A fan favorite in New York, David Lee recently went Hollywood in an all-new episode of the popular "Family Feud" program.

In a special sweeps-week promotion that will air from Monday to Friday, the long-running game show underwent a basketball make-over. In a true comedic moment not to be missed, Lee faces off against his mother, Susan, to find out what the "Survey Says."

To celebrate these shows, the "Family Feud" set was overhauled for a special basketball look. The NBA Mothers' portion of the set was decorated around a "living room" theme featuring NBA "DreamSeats" and a special *NBA Live 08* game broadcast from Electronic Arts. Additionally, a separate "basketball court" area was installed on the set complete with an NBA 54-inch Backboard System, NBA game balls and an NBA Ball Truck.
